

AMBASSADOR VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

Ambassadors are short-term volunteers who open doors for our organization in the community, introducing new people by hosting and filling a private Point of Entry with ten or more guests.

Pre-requisites:

- Gold Standard: A passion for the mission of _____
- Prior Point of Entry attendance

Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Hosts and fills a private Point of Entry Event for ten or more guests within three months of agreeing to become an Ambassador. This can be a Point of Entry in someone's home or office or at the organization's offices.
2. Informs guests of what the Point of Entry will be about, that they will receive one Follow-Up Call from the organization, and that they will not be asked for money.
3. Aims to have at least one of their guests become an Ambassador after the Point of Entry Event.
4. Delivers the welcome and close to their guests by using the How to Open & Close Your Point of Entry Program.

Length of Service:

Ambassadors will complete their commitment of hosting and filling a Point of Entry with ten or more guests within three months. Ambassador has the option to complete after one term, continue for another term, or get involved in other ways.
